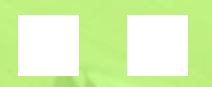
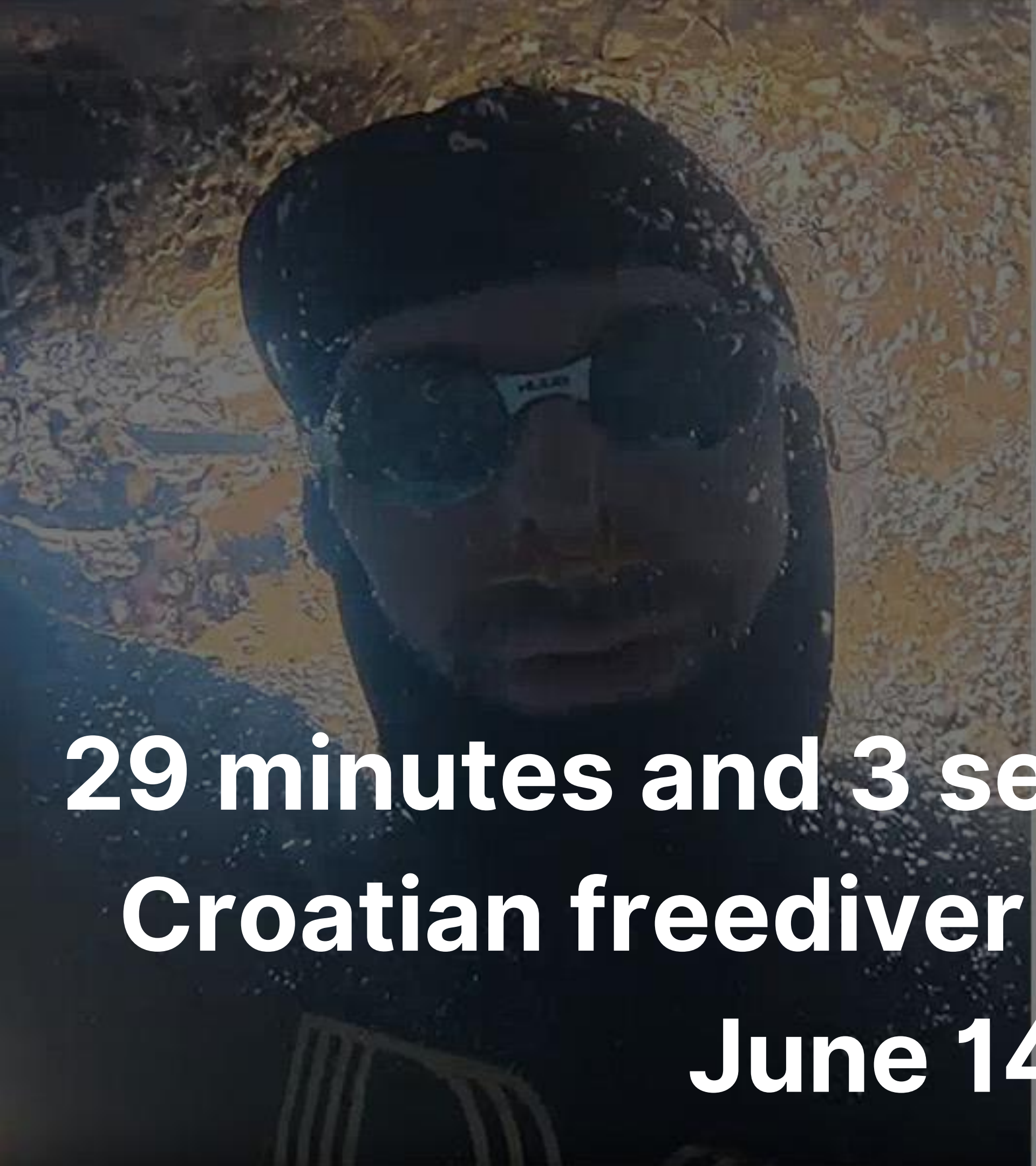

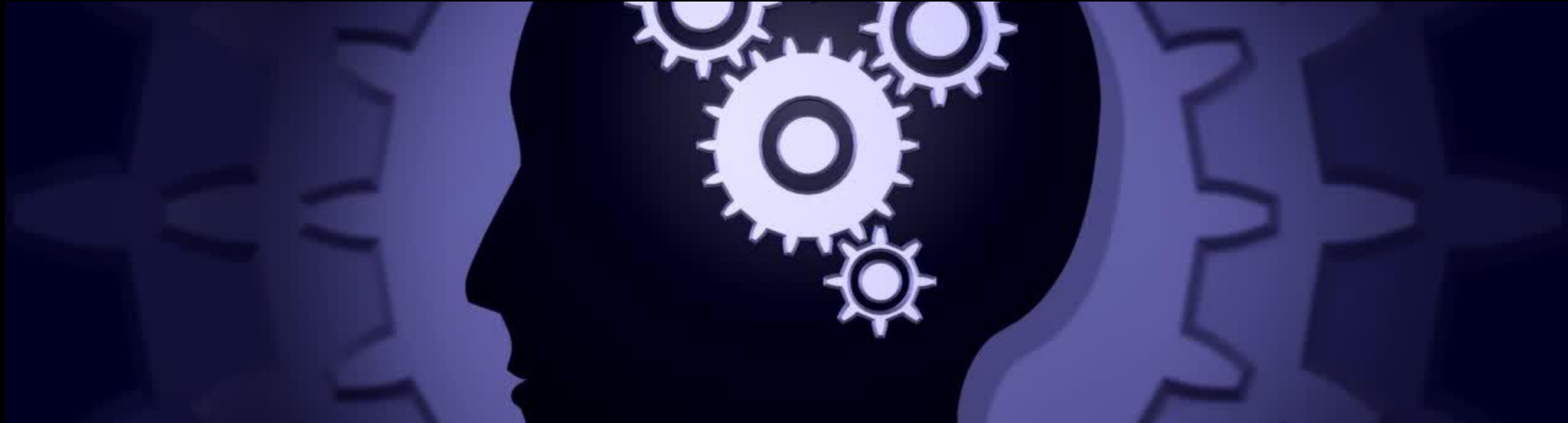

- Quantifying **Disengagement/ Presenteeism**
